Beginning at 3:00pm, we will offer Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, Followed by singing the Chaplet, The Litany of Trust in the Divine Mercy, and concluding with Benediction.

Jesus, I Trust in You

Chaplet of Divine Mercy

Opening Prayer (optional):

You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls and the ocean of Mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty yourself out upon us.

Then, 3 times: O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the heart of Jesus as a fount of Mercy for us, I trust in You.

1. Begin with the Sign of the Cross,
1 Our Father, 1 Hail Mary, The Apostles Creed
2. Then on the Our Father Beads say the following:
***Eternal Father, I offer You The Body, and Blood, Soul and Divinity
Of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ,
In atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.***
3. On the 10 Hail Mary Beads say the following:
***For the sake of His sorrowful Passion,
Have mercy on us and on the whole world.***
(Repeat step 2 and 3 for all five decades)
4. Conclude with (three times):
***Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One,
have mercy on us and on the whole world.***

Closing Prayer (optional): *O God, in Whom mercy is endless and the treasure of compassion inexhaustible, look kindly on us and increase Your mercy in us that in difficult moments we might not despair, nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to your holy will which and love and Mercy itself.*

† Our Sacramental Policy †

Six-month Parish registration and participation are required for Baptism, Confirmation and Marriage.

Baptisms: Second Sunday of the month; Arrangements must be made in advance and parents must attend a baptism class. The Church requires that at least one of the parents be a practicing Catholic; and anyone wishing to serve as a Godparent must be an active, practicing, fully initiated Catholic at least 16 years of age.

Marriage: Arrangements must be made at least nine months in advance. Please call the rectory office. Officiate at the ceremony must be St. Anthony Parish Pastor or a family member.

Funerals: Officiate must be St. Anthony Parish Pastor or a family member.

Please note: The services of the Parish Organist are used for all sacramental liturgies.
