† Our Sacramental Policy †

Six-month Parish registration and participation are required for Baptism, Confirmation and Marriage.

Baptisms: Second Sunday of the month; Arrangements must be made in advance and parents must attend a baptism class. The Church requires that at least one of the parents be a practicing Catholic; and the Godparents must be active, practicing, fully initiated Catholics at least 16 years of age. If two Godparents: must be 1 male & 1 female; if one Godparent: may be male or female.

Marriage: Arrangements must be made at least nine months in advance. Please call the rectory office. Officiate at the ceremony must be St. Anthony Parish Pastor or a family member.

Funerals: Officiate must be St. Anthony Parish Pastor or a family member.

Please note: The services of the Parish Organist are used for all sacramental liturgies.

Catholic Services Appeal 2011

Dear Friends in Christ,

Each year, all parishes in the Archdiocese of Detroit embark upon the CSA (Catholic Services Appel) Drive. The CSA is a required collection taken up for the general operational expenses of the Archdiocese of Detroit. It helps to subsidize Catholic institutions that may not necessarily be connected to or funded by a particular parish. Among these special services are Campus Ministry, Telecommunications, Hospital and Prison Chaplaincies, Central Service Offices, which provide direct assistance to individual parishes, the Marriage Tribunal, and the like. Since the CSA provides for 62% of the operating budget of the Archdiocese, we are assessed or taxed a specific amount we are asked to meet.

The amount assessed to St. Anthony Parish this year is **\$45,065**. In order to reach our goal, the suggested pledged amount will be **\$150** from each family. Our assessment is based upon many factors, including parish registration, Sunday collections, and financial status of the area within our parish boundaries.

As an incentive for the collection of these necessary moneys, the Archdiocese offers a rebate to the parish for any additional moneys collected above and beyond our quota.

For your convenience, pledge forms can be found at the bottom of this page. Please complete the form and designate the amount of your pledge and the payment plan you prefer and return to the Parish Office. Your pledge can be made in several ways: paid in full and returned with your pledge form; a down payment returned with your pledge form, with the balance divided into quarterly payments, or divided evenly among 9 monthly payments. **Credit card and automatic withdrawal payments will also be accepted.** If you wish to contribute this way, please indicate on the line below and a form will be sent to you.

Pledge forms will continue to be available in the bulletin, and tables will be set up in the Narthex after all Masses on May 28 & 29. Pledges may be made at this time, you may mail in your pledge, drop it in the collection basket, or you may phone in your pledge through the Parish Office by calling 734-854-1143 during regular business hours.

I am grateful for your continued stewardship and prayers.

Rules for St. Anthony Cemetery

approved March 22, 2011

the Parish Pastoral/Financial Council

at the recommendation of

St. Anthony Cemetery Committee

- One of the following decorations is permitted per grave: Either one eternal light or one potted plant that is contained in a Cemetery Cone (permitted in summer only).
- Grave blankets may be placed in addition to one of the above decorations, November – April only. Must be removed by April 1.
- Funeral Flowers are to be removed by the family no later than 3 days after the funeral.
- Decorations which do not conform to the above specifications will be removed.
- Please place all refuse in the containers provided.
- Please close the Cemetery gate when leaving.
