



† Our Sacramental Policy †

Six-month Parish registration and participation are required for Baptism, Confirmation and Marriage.

Baptisms: Arrangements must be made in advance and parents must attend a baptism class. The Church requires that at least one of the parents be a practicing Catholic, and the Godparents must be active, practicing, fully initiated Catholics at least 16 years of age. If two Godparents: must be 1 male & 1 female; if one Godparent: may be male or female.

Marriage: Arrangements must be made at least nine months in advance. Please call the Parish Office. Officiate at the ceremony must be St. Anthony Parish Pastor or a family member.

<u>Funerals:</u> Officiate must be St. Anthony Parish Pastor or a family member.

Please note: The services of the Parish Organist are used for all sacramental liturgies.

St. Anthony Prayer Blankets

St. Anthony Prayer Blanket Ministry began years ago by Sandy Maenle as a way to share our prayers with those who have special requests.

Our usual schedule for prayer blankets was put on hold for a while due to a variety of reasons. We've gotten back on track: Prayer blankets are again placed on display in the Narthex on the 1st Sunday of the month for Parishioners to tie a knot in the yarn of the patchwork blankets as they offer a prayer for whoever will be receiving it. Then, on Tuesday that week, following morning Mass, members of the ministry gather in the Narthex to work on the blankets to ready them for distribution. Sandy then beautifully personalizes each blanket for individual recipient. The ministry even creates prayer swatches suitable for military personnel, that can be kept with them.

Over the years, we have distributed over 1,000 blankets, for requests ranging from help in times of loss, celebrating joyful events, healing, or a wide variety of needs that have been brought to us.

We always welcome new members; sewing skills are welcome, but are not mandatory.
