from you.*

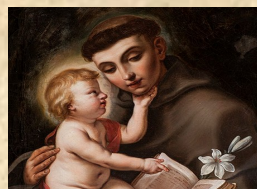

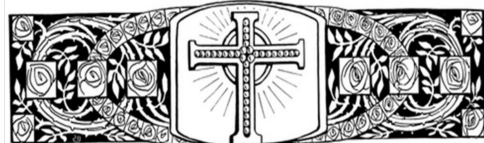
