THE SOCIETY FOR THE PROGATION OF THE FAITH ANNUAL MISSION APPEAL COMING JULY 18 & 19



Dear Parishioners

The weekend of July 18 & 19th Fr. Joseph Komaravalli is visiting our parish for a Mission Appeal for his Diocese of Khammam from the state of Telanagan, South India. He was ordained for the Diocese of Khammam on December 21st 1994. Khammam is a Mission Diocese serving Dalits, Tribals and underprivileged people of God, about 250,000 Catholics. Our concept of Evangelization is designed through Education, Health Care, Empowerment of Women, Youth Ministry and Social Development and Welfare Activities.

The Diocese has 83 Parishes, 950 Mission centres. They have 81 Diocesan Priests, 60 Religious Priests, 350 Women Religious, 355 Catechists, and 70 Seminarians in the formation to be future Missionary priests for the diocese and the Universal Church. All Mission centres are in the remote and rural areas. They have 15 schools and 2 colleges educating about 6,000 providing the orphan, semi-orphan and poor children with free food and boarding. They have two special schools for Blind, Deaf and Dumb and also for the children with multiple disabilities, caring for 150 children with free food and boarding with special medical care. Also a Home for the elderly men and women who are aged and sick, who are literally abandoned with no one's care. Besides this they also have mobile medical health activities with free medical camps and free distribution of medicine in 950 Mission centres daily. They have huge responsibilities for the maintenance of the priests, Catechists and animators. They also need to construct a couple of chapels and rectories in the new mission centres. They are in need of building a Priests' retirement home. They also have the need to provide clean drinking water for the people in the villages by digging bore wells and installing water plants, to support part-financing for the poor to complete their houses and to have a toilet. The second collection of the Masses will be sent for the Mission needs of the Diocese of Khammam. Please be generous.

Please be sure to welcome Fr. Komaravalli with warm St. Anthony hospitality.

Catholic Services Appeal 2026

Dear Friends in Christ,

Each year, all parishes in the Archdiocese of Detroit embark upon the CSA (Catholic Services Appel) Drive. The CSA is a required collection taken up for the general operational expenses of the Archdiocese of Detroit. It helps to subsidize Catholic institutions that may not necessarily be connected to or funded by a particular parish. Among these special services are Campus Ministry, Telecommunications, Hospital and Prison Chaplaincies, Central Service Offices, which provide direct assistance to individual parishes, the Marriage Tribunal, and the like. Since the CSA provides for 62% of the operating budget of the Archdiocese, we are assessed or taxed a specific amount we are asked to meet. Our assessment is based upon many factors, including parish registration, Sunday collections, and financial status of the area within our parish boundaries. The detail of how our assessment is calculated, as well as how the money is used may be found on the insert included with today's bulletin.

The amount assessed to St. Anthony Parish this year is **\$42,535**. In order to reach our goal, the recommended pledge amount will be **\$300** from each family.

For your convenience, pledge forms can be found at the bottom of this page. Please complete the form and designate the amount of your pledge and the payment plan you prefer and return to the Parish Office. Pledges may also be made by calling the Parish Office 734-854-1143; sending your pledge via email (stanthony@bex.net) or by stopping by the Parish Office during regular business hours.

Your pledge can be made in several ways: paid in full and returned with your pledge form; a down payment returned with your pledge form, with the balance divided into quarterly payments, or divided evenly among 9 monthly payments. Credit card and automatic withdrawal payments and electronic funds transfers (EFT) will also be accepted. If you wish to contribute this way, please go to: give.aodcsa.org. Please select "St. Anthony, Temperance" on the online form where indicated. Donors may also call (888) 331-8695 to make an online or EFT request.

Please note: If you sign up to make payments on your pledge, the payment schedule will not begin until July 2026.

Please remember that we are required to make an accounting of all CSA cards for our Parish, so even if you are unable to pledge, we ask that you indicate that to the Parish Office as well.

I am grateful for your continued stewardship and prayers.

Pray

Pray before, during, and after filling out the online survey. Invite the Holy Spirit to work through you as you answer the questions, remove any barrier or bias, and help you share what works or doesn't work in the proposed models. Thank you for your continual support.

In our first six months of our fiscal year (October-March) SVdP assisted 38 families (68 Adults 37 Children) The assistance included rent 12 times for \$7033, utilities 4 times for \$1567, food pantry 46 visits and provided 58 set ups (each set up includes 3 boxes of food) for approximate value \$3480, and \$300 worth of gift cards for perishable food and gasoline.

Gabriel's Gift Baby Closet has had 272 visits; we average between 45-55 families each month (98 adults and 146 children). The Lord has blessed us with and we have welcomed 10 new babies all born since October 1. We provided over \$30,000 worth of goods which included \$6300 for diapers, \$1500 for pull ups, \$2950 for formula/baby food, \$700 for wipes, \$1700 for personal hygiene products, \$8500 in clothing, and many more items such as car seats, pack and plays, high chairs, bassinets, cribs, bouncers, blankets, burp clothes and bottles. We very much appreciate all the donations both monetary and physical goods so that we can carry on with our mission.
